Barricade/Cone/Vest Permit for use on Public Right of Way

1. The City of Medford will be held harmless for any accidents incurred by people or firms placing items in the public right of way.
2. Barricades and cones can be borrowed from the City of Medford. Vests, cones and barricades to the Chamber of Commerce at no charge. They will be signed out to the owner with a charge of \$1.00 per barricade or cone, per day. If damaged or lost, there will be a \$100.00 charge per barricade, \$60.00 per cone and \$25.00 per vest to replace.
3. The City of Medford will not be responsible for upkeep of batteries or placements of barricades borrowed by individuals or companies.
4. Barricades will be picked up and returned to the City shop during normal working hours between 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
5. If barricades are being used for a dumpster that is in the public right of way over night, you must have 3 flashing barricades outlining the object.



4th Annual LITE Foundation Glow Run

2019 Race Route

The race will start in the driveway to the Medford City Park, near the corner of Wheelock Avenue and North Washington Avenue. At the end of the driveway, it will turn left on Wheelock Avenue and run east until the road veers right and turns into Luepke Way. Follow Luepke Way to the footbridge that crosses the river. On the other side of the river, turn left to follow the Pine Line trail for 1.2 miles (the route crosses Allman Avenue). Head north to the turnaround barrel then back down the Pine Line Trail to Allman Street. The race then turns right on Allman Street, then left on Centennial Avenue. Follow Centennial Avenue to Wheelock Avenue where it turns right and brings you back to the driveway of the Medford City Park. The start and finish line are in the same location. There will be a person to direct you at each intersection.
